



Number of jobs created for 10kt of managed waste (Source ADEME, 2013)

Waste Management	Number of full-time jobs
Waste disposal / Landfill	1
Incineration	3 to 4
Compost / methanisation	11
Deconstruction / Remanufacturing	50



Job creation potential in a circular economy

EU / Country	Hypothesis	Additional Jobs
EU (GWS, 2012)	- 17 % natural resources consumption	1,4 to 2,8 millions
EU (Cambridge Eco. 2014)	+ 30 % resource productivity (2030)	2 millions
UK (WRAP, 2015)	High implementation of product-service system, recycling, remanufacturing, reuse, biofuels	517 000
Netherlands (TNO, 2013)	Metals, WEEE, Food and agriculture	54 000

Country	GHG Emission Reduction	Additional Jobs	Trade Balance Effects
France	- 66%	+ 500 000	+ 2,5% of GDP
Netherlands	- 67%	+ 200 000	+ 2,5% of GDP
Spain	- 69%	+ 400 000	+ 2% of GDP
Sweden	- 66%	+ 100 000	+ 1,5% of GDP
Finland	- 68%	+ 75 000	+ 1,5% of GDP





Position paper of the *Institut de l'économie circulaire* on the circular economy package

Key points of the circular economy package:

- Awareness on all product life-cycle stages
- Improve EPR schemes
- Reinforce consumer information on product sustainability
- Simplification of EoW criteria
- Harmonise calculation methods for recycling rates and define realistic targets
- Support innovation for circular economy





Position paper of the *Institut de l'économie circulaire* on the circular economy package

Additional measures:

- Impose a resource efficiency binding target
- Promote an incentive tax framework
- Set circular economy criteria for public procurement
- Suppress direct and indirect subsidies harmful for environment
- Measures intended to develop reparation and reuse
- Develop cooperation between private and public actors
- Promote use-centred new business models
